
Hopefully I will speak/meet some of you soon.

Energy Support Grant

- Launched in 2024, and has been accessed so far by 408 as of 21/03/2024
- On target to pay out over £0.5m in grants for 23/24 a 50% increase in grants 22/23. The trustees aim is to increase that by at least a further 50% in 24/25.
- Grant applications from 1st January 2024 is 640
